It has been so good to gather together for worship in our sanctuary once again!

Now that we have begun in-person worship at 8:30 a.m. on Sundays, here are a few reminders:

We will promote maintaining appropriate physical distancing between household groups (members of a household or family can be seated together in the sanctuary, but should maintain six feet of social distance from others.

You will need to pre-register prior to **each** service you plan to attend. Just give the church office a call at 225-6755, preferably before noon on Fridays. However, if you call after that time, just leave a voice mail message, and we will put you down for the service you want to attend.

All worshippers are required to wear a face covering inside the church building. If you don't bring your own, there will be some disposable masks available.

Hand sanitizer is available in the narthex. Please use this before entering the sanctuary.

We have marked off pews in the sanctuary to allow for physical distancing, so finding a place to sit should be easy. Please do not sit in the pews with yellow signs.

For the time being, we will only be using the screens to follow along with worship.

We will not gather offering during the service, but you can leave offerings in the basket provided at the back of the sanctuary in front of the cross stained-glass window.

Please note that our current worship plans are subject to change, depending on the status of virus spread in our community and also depending on the number of volunteers we have available to assist with in-person worship.


