Instructions for Christmas Carol Jeopardy

Open the PowerPoint from the website, and start the presentation.

Team Instructions

- 1. The team with the oldest person gets to pick the first question.
- 2. Have them select a question from one of the six categories.
- 3. Click the word QUESTION in the corresponding box.
- 4. The question slide will appear, and the Christmas carol will automatically start playing.
- 5. Let the team answer the question.
- 6. Click the SPACEBAR key to advance to the answer.
- 7. If the team is correct, they get the points. If they are wrong, the other team gets the points.
- 8. Click the HOUSE ICON in the bottom right-hand corner. This will return you to the game board. The question that has been answered is now greyed out so it cannot be chosen again
 - a. Do not hit the SPACEBAR again—this will advance to the next question, NOT take you back to the game board.
- 9. It is now the next team's turn to pick a question.
- 10. Continue play until all questions have been answered. The team with the highest point value at the end wins!

Individual/For Fun Instructions

- 1. Choose a question from one of the six categories.
- 2. Click the word QUESTION in the corresponding box.
- 3. The question slide will appear, and the Christmas carol will automatically start playing.
- 4. Answer the question.
- 5. Click the SPACEBAR key to advance to the answer.
- 6. If you are correct, you get the points. If you are wrong, no points will be rewarded (you do not have to subtract points from your score)
- 7. Click the HOUSE ICON in the bottom right-hand corner. This will return you to the game board. The question that has been answered is now greyed out so it cannot be chosen again
 - a. Do not hit the SPACEBAR again—this will advance to the next question, NOT take you back to the game board.
- 8. Continue play until all questions have been answered.
