

Bible Story: The Wedding at Cana

February 21st, 2021

1. Read the Bible story in the Spark Story Bible starting on page 410.
2. Answer the following questions:
 - a. What did the man in charge of the wedding say about the wine?

 - b. Who were Jesus's helpers in this story?

Activity: Mini Kites

Today's story is about a wedding. Jesus did something surprising at the wedding. He changed water to wine. I wonder how Jesus changed the water into wine. Allow all responses. Listen for the word "miracle." **When Jesus changed water to wine, it was a miracle or an act of faith. Faith is like the wind—we can feel it but it is unseen. Today, you will make a mini kite that flies in the wind to remind you that faith is felt but unseen.**

1. Glue the two craft sticks into an X shape.
2. Color and decorate your white paper with crayons or markers in whatever design you like!
3. Fold and tape the white paper around the mini kite sticks.
4. Trim the edge of the paper.
5. Tape or glue a piece of string to the middle of the X.
6. Run or walk quickly with your kite behind you!

It's pretty miraculous that our kites fly in wind that we can't see. When you fly your kite, remember that we celebrate Jesus' miracles.
