

# ZION LUTHERAN CHURCH 2022-2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



Zion Lutheran Church will award a scholarship to any certified post-secondary education institution. Two \$350 scholarships will be awarded for the 2022-2023 school year. One scholarship will be awarded to a current 2022 high school senior, and one scholarship will be awarded to a continuing college student.

## CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

- ∴ Applicant must be a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Aberdeen, SD.
- ∴ Applicant must be involved in church and school/community activities. College students must attend a church or Christian campus ministry in the location of their college/university.
- ∴ Applicant must have submitted an application to and/or have been accepted to a certified post-secondary education institution (college, vocational, technical, or trade school).
- ∴ Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Application forms must be *neatly* completed and submitted to Pastoral Assistant Sandra for the Scholarship Committee by **April 10, 2022 at 12:00 PM**.

1. Complete all sections of the application form. Partially completed applications will not be considered.
2. Include verification of your grade point average or submit a copy of your GPA from your last report card or transcript.
3. List your involvement in church and school/community activities.

## SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The recipient of the scholarship will be asked for a copy of the acceptance and/or enrollment for the post-secondary institution of choice. The scholarship funding will be mailed directly to the school. Please have all completed scholarship forms mailed, dropped off, or emailed to Pastoral Assistant Sandra by **April 10, 2022**. If you do not attend a post-secondary institution in the 2022-2023 school year, you will forfeit your scholarship. However, you are welcome to reapply for the next round of scholarship awards.
