First of all, this has been a frustrating time for me, health-wise, as I've been fighting a cold and allergies all of October and have had to cut back on many of the visits I'd hoped to make. I saw a doctor yesterday and hopefully am in the process of getting "back to normal" and being able to do home Communion visits and meet some of the seniors who don't get out much. I have a list of people I hope to see but please call the church if you'd like me to stop by also. My unofficial goal is to do three or so home visits each week, once I'm healthy.

Our Grief Group continues to come together twice a month to visit, and share hopes and memories that are healing. I have also decided to post more websites that I think could be helpful in dealing with the grief process on our church Facebook page when I update the information about the next meeting. In November we will meet Tuesday, November 8 and Tuesday, November 22 in the room next to the kitchen from 10:30 – 11:30. We look at handouts that I have found and shared, we share a devotion, and we give people WHO WANT TO a time to share how their life is going now and where they may be in their own process. Here is a website that refers to Dr. Elizabeth Kubler-Ross, a psychiatrist who did pioneering work in the grief process and also was instrumental in the hospice programs of the 70's. For those of you who are about my age, you might remember that Dr Kubler-Ross spoke at the Johnson Fine Arts Center at NSU in 1976 or 1977 and I was privileged to be in the audience to hear her. We will meet in November on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup> and NOT on the 23<sup>rd</sup> as it is the day before Thanksgiving and we imagine that some families will be traveling. Then the Bible study goes on hiatus during Advent and will return in January! We will let you know our schedule later.

### **October 2022 Council Highlights**

- The Worship and Music Committee brought a motion to Council to hold three midweek Advent services with no service on Wednesday, December 21. The Council approved the motion.
- There will be a soundboard rework on Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup> following worship, as the soundboard hasn't been tuned since being installed in 2015.
- The Mission & Outreach Committee is holding a food drive to benefit the Salvation Army Snackpack program through November 13.
- Donna will be out of the office November 16-21: Pastor Jim will be gone November 23-25.

### **Special Offering** for November is SD Multicultural Ministries (Pine Ridge & Woyatan)

The ministry at the Pine Ridge Reconciliation Center seeks to foster mutual trust, respect and understanding while addressing the deep poverty that exist. There are four main ministries that operate out of our building: baskets, cultural immersions, Lakota Job Corp, and children and youth.

Woyatan Lutheran Church in Rapid City is an emerging ministry of the ELCA. In Lakota "woyatan" means praise and thanks. At our church, we include parts of Native American spirituality to tell the Christian story. We offer clothing, feeding, and discipleship programs, as well as a cancer care group, Fathers Against Meth, and re-entry programs for those who have been in prison.


