## Pastor Jim's News

I have mixed emotions as I write this final article for Zion's newsletter. I am officially resigning as the interim pastor for Zion Lutheran effective January 1, 2024; my final Sunday leading worship will be December 31.

I am relocating back to Nebraska - where I first retired in January 2015. I will be serving in the Wayne, NE area - doing a part-time interim at Wayne State as the LuMin campus pastor and serving as a part-time interim pastor in two smaller churches in Emerson - about 15 miles east of Wayne.

Since I want to be on-site and prepared for the spring semester at Wayne State, I need to be down there as quickly as possible, so I hope to have a U-Haul rented before New Years' Day. I also intend to have everything put away and be ready to be packed into the truck the morning of Monday, January 1. If I can get a good crew of people on Monday morning and we can get everything packed and the CRV on the trailer, I'd like to leave Aberdeen around noon so I can drive the 300+ miles to Wayne in the afternoon and get there before it gets dark. Then the folks there can unpack the truck for me as I settle back into being a Nebraskan.

Let me tell you how thankful I am that Pastor Nicole will be my successor here at Zion! She brings with her wisdom, perspective, maturity, and a willingness to learn who you all are and how you do ministry together. I know you will allow her (just as you allowed me) to learn these things when I arrived here September 1, 2022 as I began our shared journey. She and Richard will be blessed by your companionship just as you will be blessed by theirs.

This is a gifted congregation composed of active, committed volunteers serving in many areas. To me, it is functioning in several positive ways, willing to experiment to see what might work a bit better (in programming, events, and organization), and willing to take an honest look at Zion's past, present, and future.

It has been a blessing for me to have served you for 16 months as your interim pastor, and I will leave you with a favorite section of Scripture. Saint Paul writes to the church he started and shares with them

his feelings in Philippians 1:3-11. Please take the time to read this and continue to lift one another up in prayer.


