Grace and peace to you, beloved,

As we step into the month of October, we begin to see and feel the playful effects of light and dark in our lives. Thrivent Action Team Grants




Our van ride service is available on Sunday mornings for the 9:00 AM worship service. If you would like a ride to worship, please call the church office at 225-6755.




