# **Dwelling in the Word**

Dwelling in the Word is an opportunity for us to speak as one voice with shared prayers for the church, the world, and all those in need. For this practice, you are invited to meditate on the associated scripture, creating room for divine encounter with God through God's word for us. Stay with this text all week, being bold to let it speak to you in new ways each day.

As you dwell with the text, give yourself permission to ask: What caught your attention? What brought you joy/comfort? What did you struggle with or made you uncomfortable? What questions arise from the reading? What part of this scripture will you carry with you today? As you dwell with God this week may the angels surround you as companions in the journey.

**Meditation Text:** Dear Lord as I engage **Psalm 139** today, please allow your words to wash over me. Let them be a gateway into understanding you more fully. Amen.

### Psalm 139

<sup>1</sup>O LORD, you have searched me and known me.

<sup>2</sup>You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from far away.

<sup>3</sup>You search out my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways.

<sup>4</sup>Even before a word is on my tongue,

O LORD, you know it completely.

<sup>5</sup>You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me.

<sup>6</sup>Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;

it is so high that I cannot attain it.

<sup>7</sup>Where can I go from your spirit?

Or where can I flee from your presence?

<sup>8</sup>If I ascend to heaven, you are there;

if I make my bed in Sheol, you are there.

<sup>9</sup>If I take the wings of the morning

and settle at the farthest limits of the sea,

<sup>10</sup>even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me fast. <sup>11</sup>If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light around me become night,"

<sup>12</sup>even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is as bright as the day, for darkness is as light to you.

<sup>13</sup>For it was you who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb.

<sup>14</sup>I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; that I know very well.

15My frame was not hidden from you,
when I was being made in secret,

intricately woven in the depths of the earth.

<sup>16</sup>Your eyes beheld my unformed substance.

In your book were written all the days that were formed for me, when none of them as yet existed.

<sup>17</sup>How weighty to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

<sup>18</sup>I try to count them — they are more than the sand; I come to the end — I am still with you.

<sup>19</sup>O that you would kill the wicked, O God, and that the bloodthirsty would depart from me —

<sup>20</sup>those who speak of you maliciously,

and lift themselves up against you for evil!

<sup>21</sup>Do I not hate those who hate you, O LORD?

And do I not loathe those who rise up against you?

<sup>22</sup>I hate them with perfect hatred; I count them my enemies.

<sup>23</sup>Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts.

<sup>24</sup>See if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

**Prayer of the Week:** Holy Trinity, make yourself known to us, the body of Zion Lutheran. Search us for the inconsistencies that keep us from fully engaging your mission. Reveal to us the ways we can step with more boldness into your mission of connecting people to the Gospel and pointing to the way of restoration and healing that comes through you. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
