Dwelling in the Word

Dwelling in the Word is an opportunity for us to speak as one voice with shared prayers for the church, the world, and all those in need. For this practice, you are invited to meditate on the associated scripture, creating room for divine encounter with God through God's word for us. Stay with this text all week, being bold to let it speak to you in new ways each day.

As you dwell with the text, give yourself permission to ask: What caught your attention? What brought you joy/comfort? What did you struggle with or made you uncomfortable? What questions arise from the reading? What part of this scripture will you carry with you today? As you dwell with God this week may the angels surround you as companions in the journey.

Meditation Text: Dear Lord as I engage **Jeremiah 18:1-11** today, please allow your words to wash over me. Let them be a gateway into understanding you more fully. Amen.

Jeremiah 18:1-11

¹This is the message that came to Jeremiah from the Lord: ² "Jeremiah, go down to the potter's house. I will give you my message there." ³ So I went down to the potter's house and saw him working with clay at the wheel. ⁴ He was making a pot from clay. But there was something wrong with the pot. So the potter used that clay to make another pot. With his hands he shaped the pot the way he wanted it to be. ⁵ Then this message from the Lord came to me: ⁶ "Family of Israel, you know that I can do the same thing with you. You are like the clay in the potter's hands, and I am the potter."

This message is from the Lord. ⁷ "There may come a time when I will speak about a nation or a kingdom that I will pull up by its roots or tear down and destroy it. ⁸ But if the people of that nation change their hearts and lives and stop doing evil things, I will change my mind and not bring on them the disaster I planned. ⁹ There may come another time when I speak about a nation that I will build up or plant. ¹⁰ But if I see that nation doing evil things and not obeying me, I will think again about the good I had planned to do for them. ¹¹ "So, Jeremiah, say to the people of Judah and those who live in Jerusalem, 'This is what the Lord says: I am the potter preparing troubles for you and making plans against you. So stop doing the evil things you are doing. Each person must change and start doing good.'

Prayer of the Week: Holy Trinity, make yourself known to us, the body of Zion Lutheran. Help us to be like clay that you are molding for your mission. Use us, our hands, feet, and thinking to be proclaimers of the gospel in Word and deed, as we step with more confidence into your purpose of the church, connecting people to the Gospel and pointing to the way of restoration and healing that comes through you. Move us to claim our baptismal identity as your disciples, not just members of an organization. Help us see your work with curiosity, revealing to us how the provision of space and people at Zion can be of better service to the community of Aberdeen. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
