

SERVICE CHALLENGE

DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

Prayer of the Week

God of greatness, from the beginning you were there. Out of nothing, you created every animal, plant, and person. You breathed your Spirit of life into creation and called it good. Be with us this day as we rise with the sun and sleep with the moon and stars. And with each new day, create within us a reflection of your love.

Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Highs & Lows: What is one thing you saw in creation that made you happy? What is one thing you saw in creation that made you sad or angry?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: God made everything in creation from the mountains to the ocean, from the flowers to the fields. What was something you did today in God's creation?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: God promised Abraham a son. Late in his life, baby Isaac was born. God kept God's promise to Abraham. What good news have you heard—or experienced—today? What unpleasant news have you heard?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

Have each person finish this prayer: Dear God, Thank you for [name something in creation]. Help me [name something you need help with]. Amen.

CLOSING

- If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
- Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share With permission, mark one another with the sign of the cross on each other's hands or forehead, and say, "You are created in God's image. Amen."
